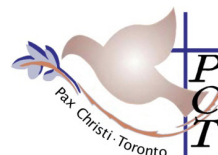
Statement Frayba

In Solidarity with FRAYBA, Mexico

Pax Christi International and its partners express great concern about the serious and recurrent anonymous threats against our member organization in Mexico, the Centre for Human Rights Fray Bartolomé de las Casas ([FRAYBA](#)), for its work defending human rights of the indigenous and rural population population in the region of Chiapas, and threats against its partner organization, the Colectivo de Familiares de Presos en Lucha, since November (statement from Frayba).

We ask the Mexican government and the State of Chiapas to protect and guarantee security measures and protection to Frayba members and people who are assisting in legal cases with Frayba and we ask the international community to express solidarity through political support for protection of their work in defence and promotion of human rights.

Pax Christi International is a Catholic movement with consultative status at the United Nations with partners in Latin America, including Chiapas and Oaxaca in Mexico. Inspired by the encyclical Laudato Si' and through a rights-based approach, our peace movement accompanies, organizations and communities defending their territories from extractives projects and their impacts on environment, people's culture, and communities' sustainability.
