into Japanese territory.

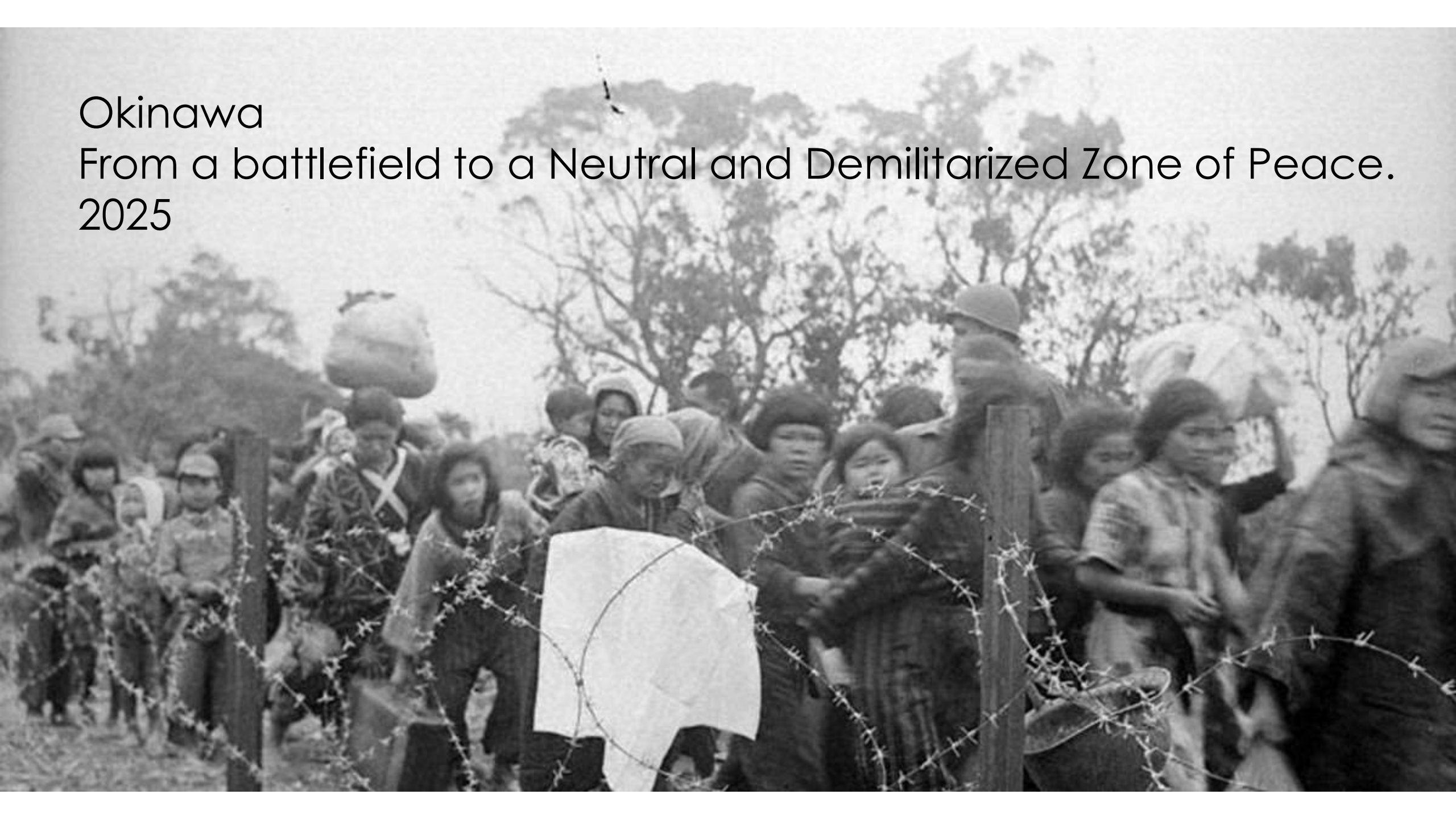


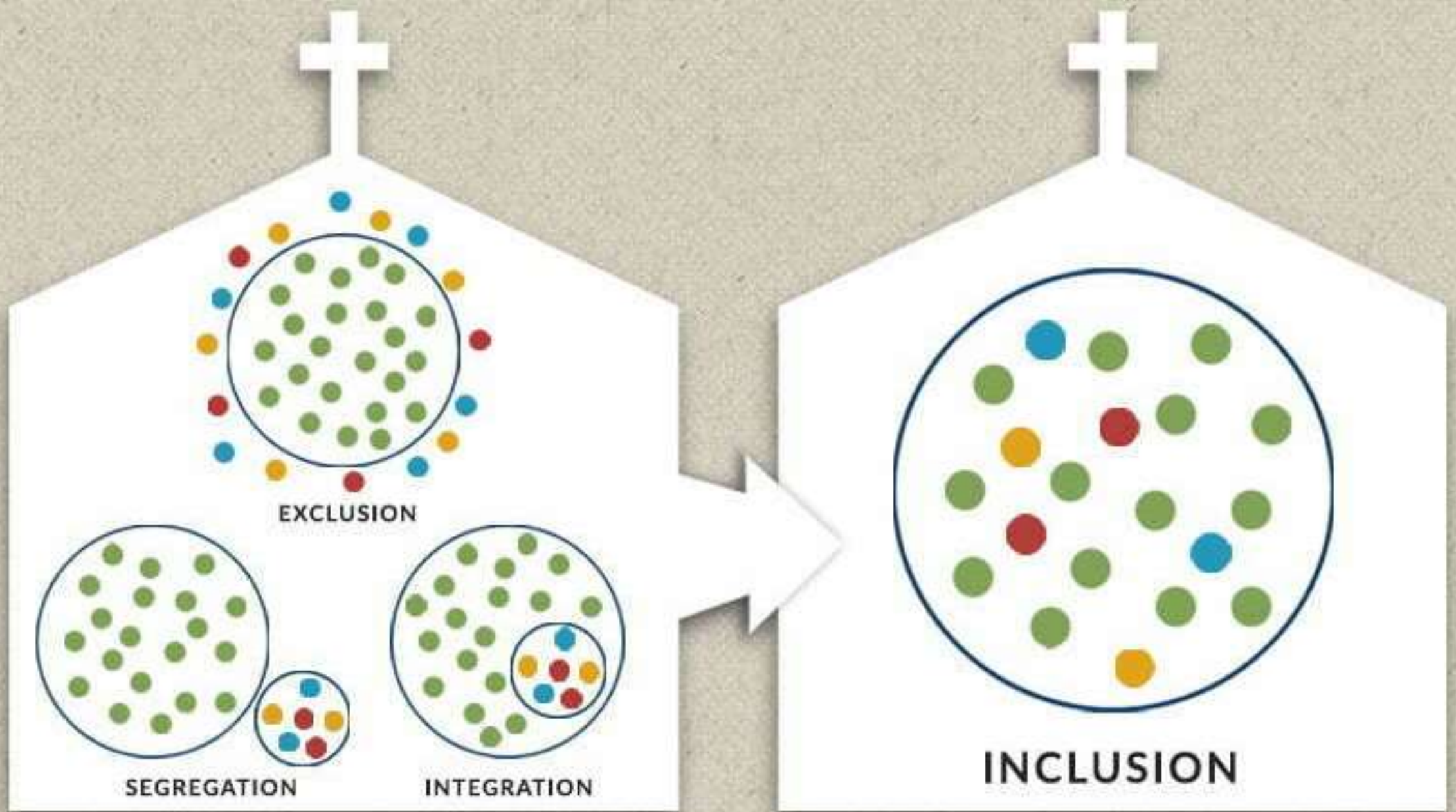
