NON-VIOLENCE AS A STRATEGIC CHOICE:

Elements

- tactics that grow participation
- unity of goal, method of struggle and leadership
- shifts the power balance

Strategy in practice

- mass participation - practice and strengthened agency
- building of alternative institutions
- building of civic infrastructure
- mass withdrawal of cooperation
- MOVEMENT!

Contributions

- community activities - increase the cost for actors practicing violence
- civil society helps alternative voices survive
- builds bridges and helps reconstruct post-conflict
- builds the muscle for governance

The Sudanese non-violence resistance to violence now is a continuation, development, and adaptation of the tactics that have been learned in the revolution



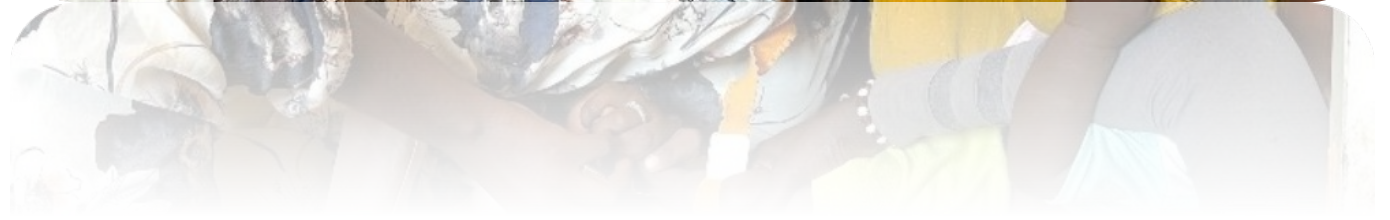

THE CHALLENGES

I. The reality of war and the sheer scale of crimes is fertile soil for hatred, anger and advocacy for violence, making the option of non-violence and rejection of war unrealistic



2. The war economy and the dire conditions of refugees attract activists to the war square and make the process of resistance difficult



3. Most refugee-receiving countries have laws limiting the activities of peace movements



4. Conflicts and the difficulty of building alliances in the peace square
