Via Dolorosa is a four-part documentary tracing 2,000 years of Palestinian Christian history. Through persecution, occupation, and displacement, it tells a powerful story of faith, resilience, and steadfast belonging.

The film explores the struggles and contributions of Palestinian Christians as they preserve their heritage and identity against immense challenges. More than a historical account, Via Dolorosa is a moving testament to hope, justice, and an unbroken connection to their ancestral homeland.
